Why the Service Line Inventory?

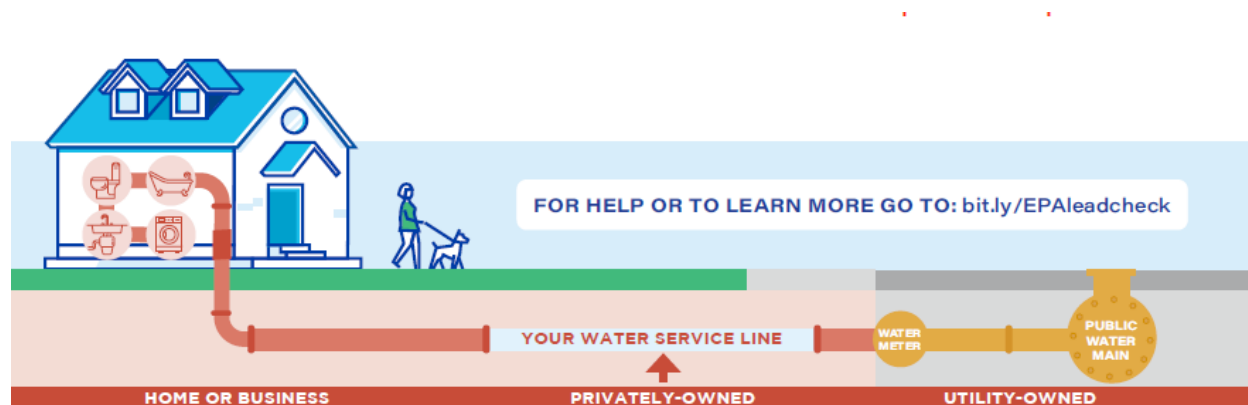

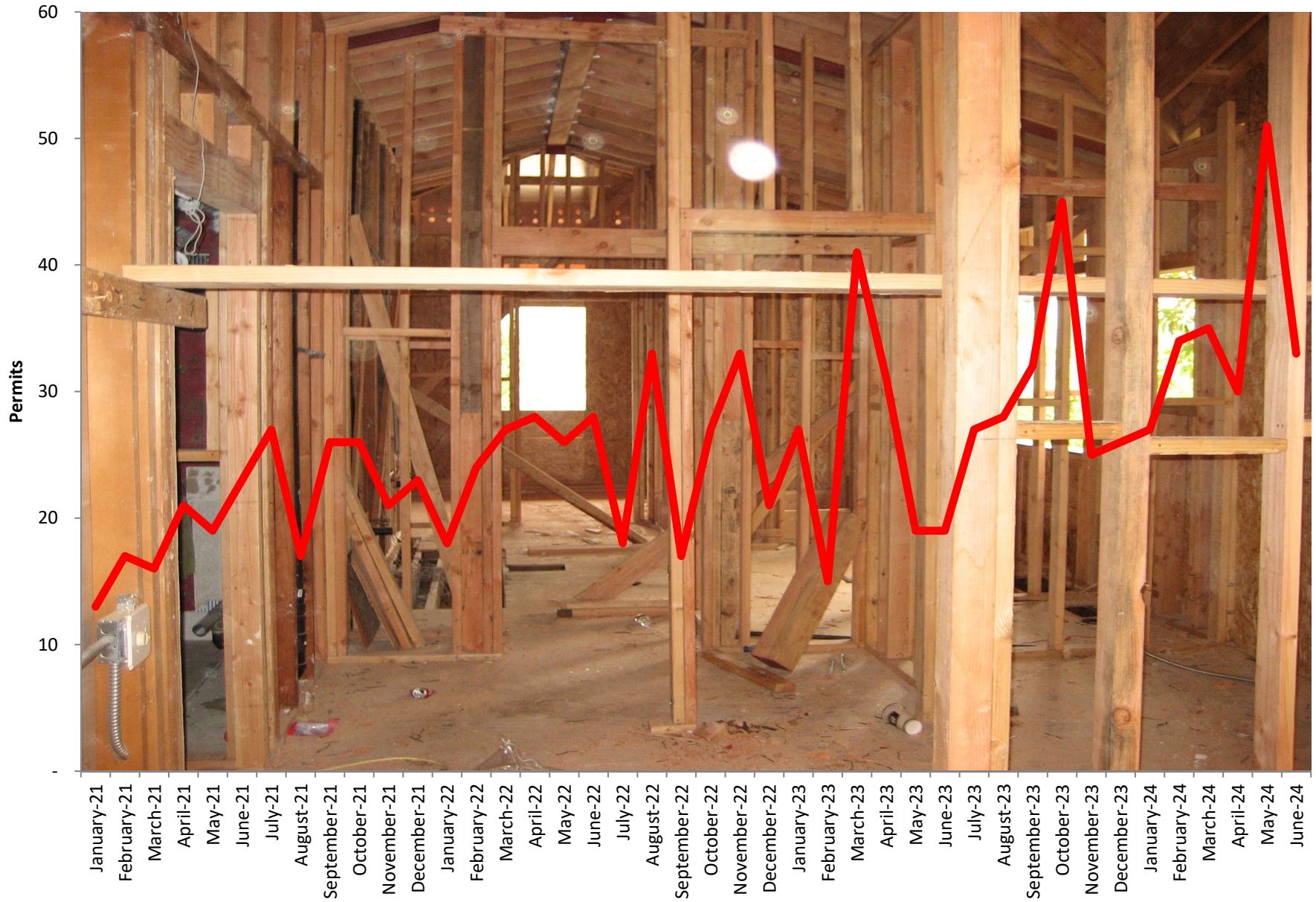

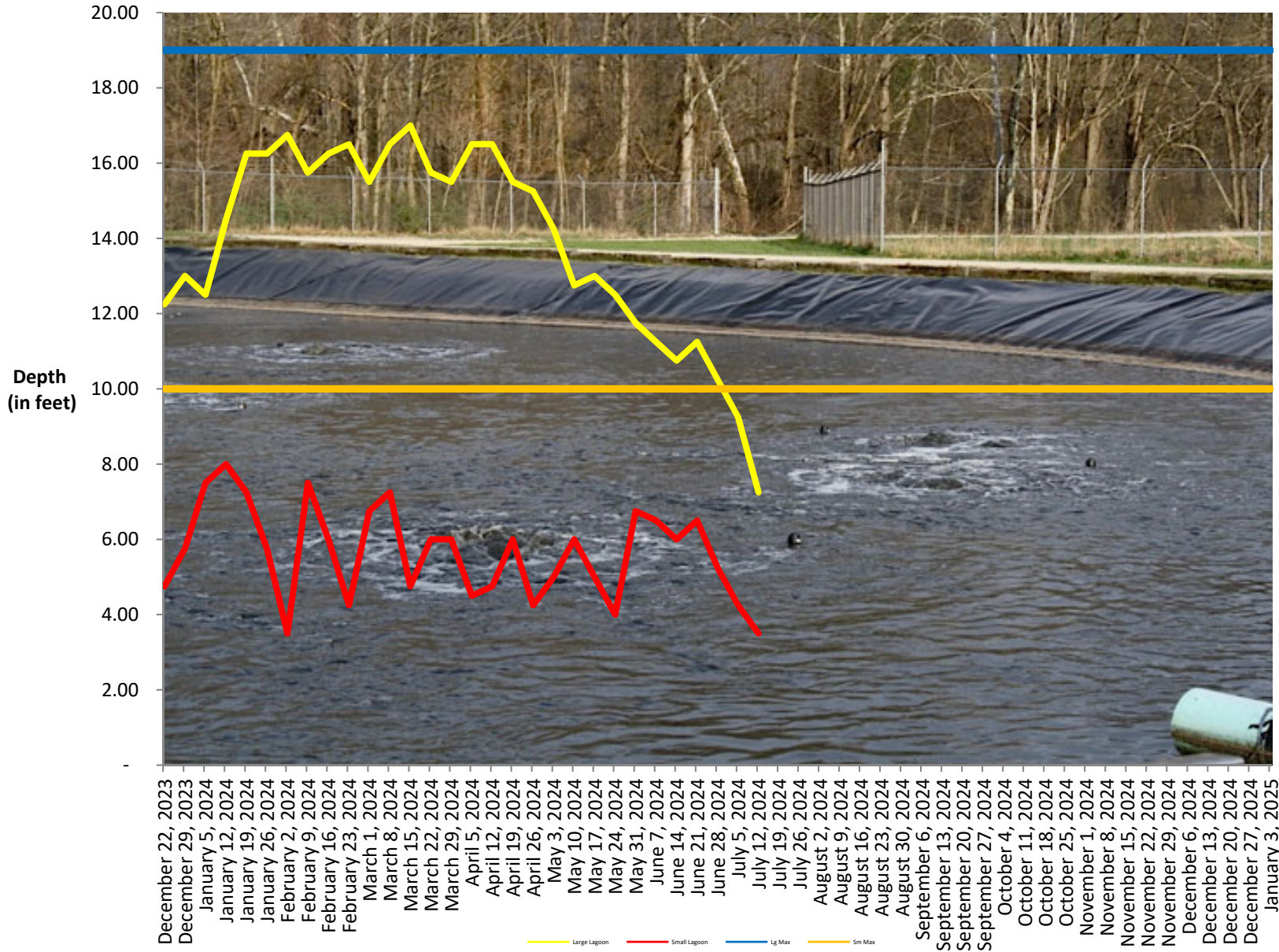

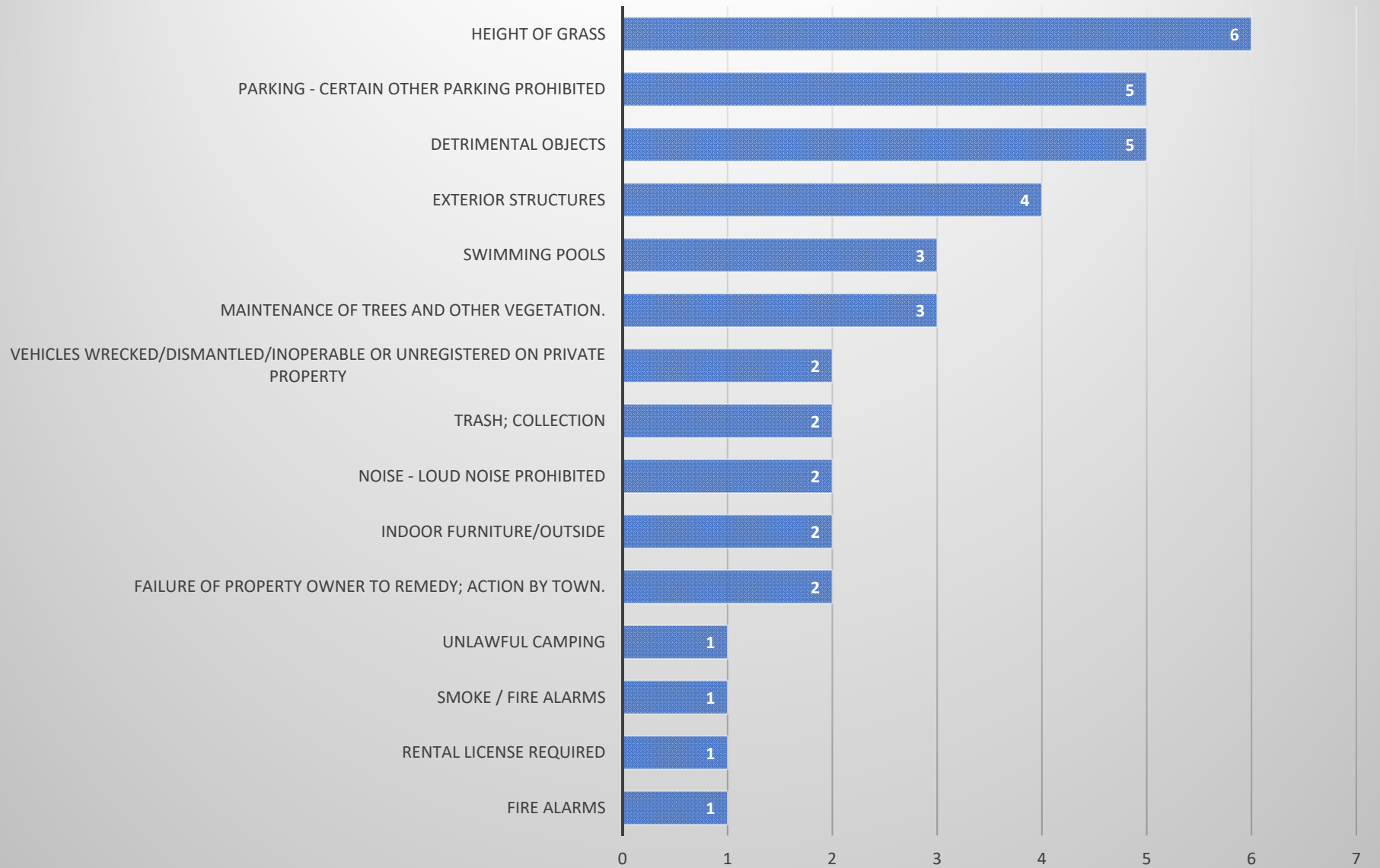
Building Permit Activity

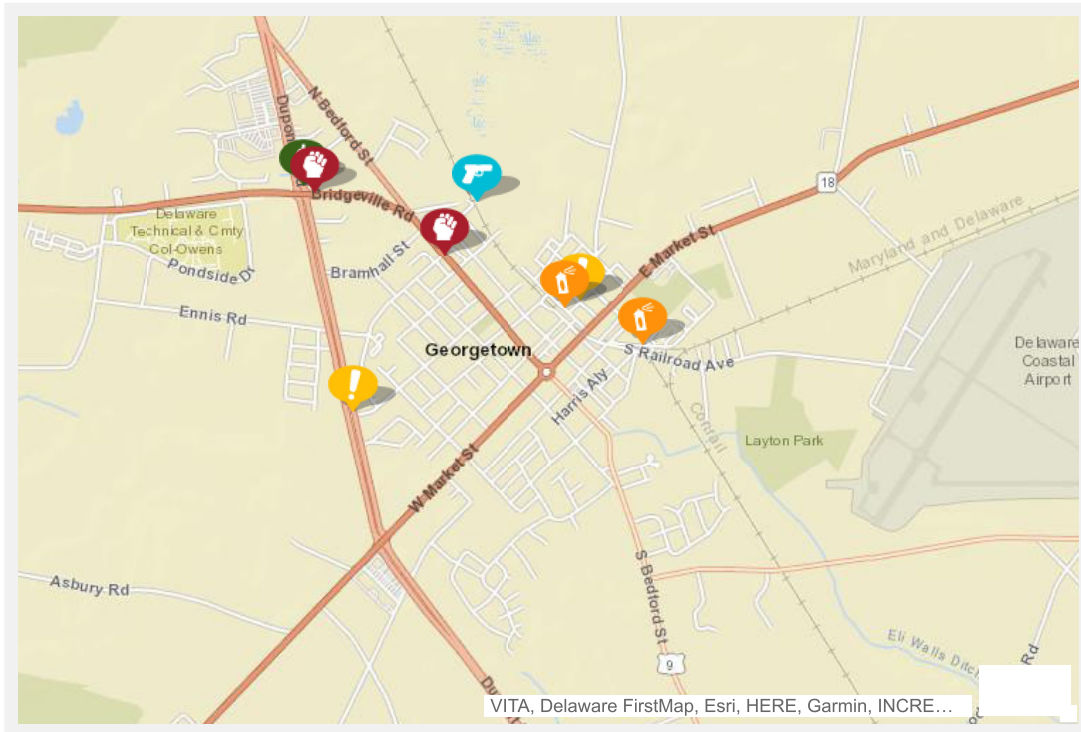

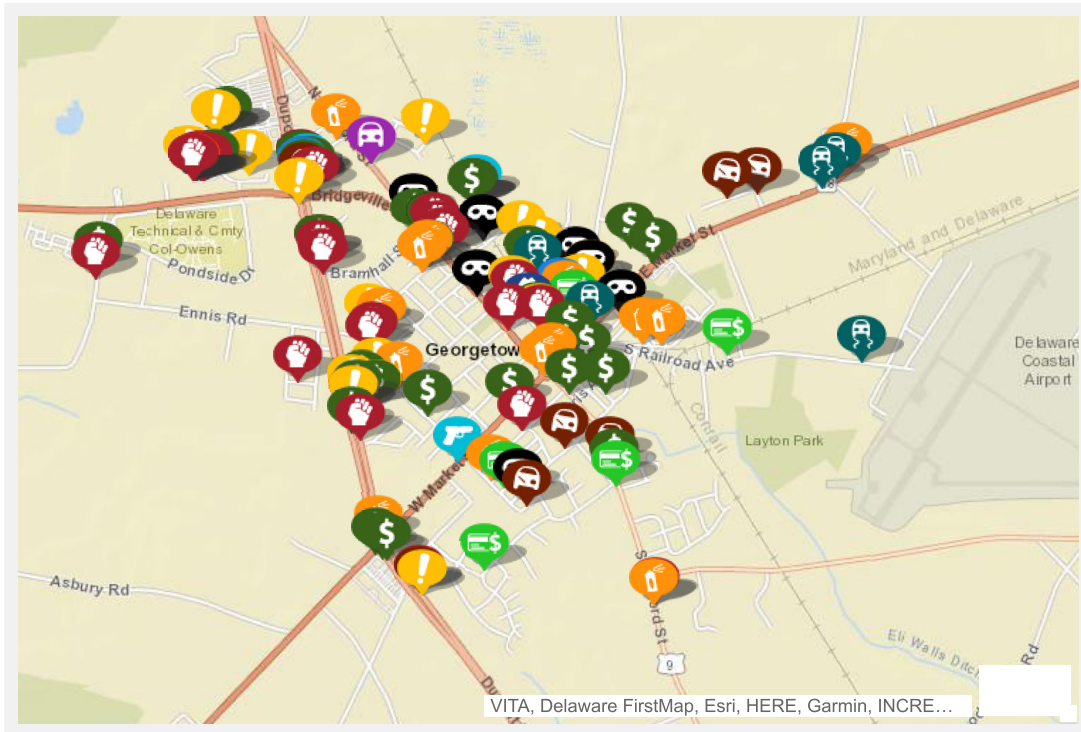
