

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

# **Overview**



# **Highlights**

- Stifel served as sole manager for the Town of Georgetown's General Obligation Bonds, Series of 2025, which priced on Thursday, January 30, 2025.
- The Town is the county seat of Sussex County, DE located approximately 32 miles south of the state capitol of Dover and has an approximately population of 7,100 residents.
- Proceeds for the issue will be used finance the construction of and site improvements for a new police station and public
  works building as well as improvements to the Town's Water and Sewer Systems.
- Stifel previously served as sole manager for the Town's General Obligation Bonds, Series of 2021 refunding issuance.
- The financing team including Stifel, PFM (Town's Municipal Advisor) and the Onix Group (Town's developer) worked closely with the Town's administration in plan of finance development for several months leading up to a very successful pricing.

## **Structure**

- The Bonds were structured to provide aggregate level debt service amongst the Town's General Fund, Water Fund and Sewer Fund.
- The Bonds were issued with a first optional redemption date of June 1, 2032, approximately a 7-year par call.

# Results

- Stifel pre-marketed the issue at very aggressive rates relative to other similar transactions in the market.
- The Stifel underwriting team was able to generate an order book consisting of 26 distinct institutional investors as well as multiple retail accounts.
- Orders totaled \$96.7 million or approximately 5.8x the par amount of bonds offered.
- Given the level of subscriptions generated, Stifel was able to lower yields by as much as 10 basis points across multiple
  maturities during pricing.




# **Market Commentary**

# **Pre-Pricing / Pricing**

- The FOMC met the day before pricing and opted to keep rates steady after lowering rates 100 bps in a matter of four months at the end of last year.
- Municipal supply the week of pricing was \$8.7 billion, somewhat higher than the 2025 weekly average of \$7.7 billion.
- Municipal bond funds reported net inflows of \$741.7 million the week of bond pricing, bringing the 4-week average to \$1.5 billion of inflows.
- During the week of pricing, the BVAL Index decreased by 6-8 basis points.


