COMMUNITY UPDATE MARCH 2025

Georgetown North Groundwater Superfund Site

The Superfund site in Georgetown, Delaware consists of soil and groundwater contaminated with volatile organic compounds (VOCs). The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Remedial Investigation on this Site to evaluate and determine how to clean up the contamination.

During the weeks of March 31 and April 7, 2025, the EPA will collect groundwater samples through a multi-level sampling in Georgetown. The sampling will use specialized equipment to drill into the ground (as pictured) and collect groundwater samples at different depths in multiple locations. Once sampling



is completed, each borehole will be filled in and the surface will be restored to its original material (e.g., grass, gravel, asphalt, concrete). The public should expect a high level of noise when drilling (from 8 am to 5 pm on weekdays only) and the presence of trucks with auxiliary equipment during the sampling.

We thank the community for their patience and support, and we look forward to further strengthening our relationship.

ACTUALIZACIÓN A LA COMUNIDAD MARZO 2025

Sitio de Superfondo Aguas Subterráneas al Norte de Georgetown

El sitio Superfondo en Georgetown, Delaware consiste de suelos y agua subterránea contaminados con compuestos orgánicos volátiles (VOCs). La Agencia de Protección Ambiental (EPA) está realizando una Investigación de Remediación en el Sitio para evaluar y determinar cómo limpiar esta contaminación.

Durante las semanas de Marzo 31 y Abril 7 del 2025, la EPA tomará muestras de agua subterránea mediante un muestreo multinivel en Georgetown. El muestreo usará un equipo especializado para taladrar (como en la foto) y coleccionar muestras de agua a diferentes profundidades en varias localizaciones. Una vez se



complete el muestreo, las perforaciones se rellenarán y la superficie se restaurará a su material original (por ejemplo, grama, gravilla, asfalto, concreto). El público debe esperar ruidos altos cuando se taladre en el suelo y la presencia de camiones con equipo auxiliar durante el muestreo (entre 8 am y 5pm de Lunes a Viernes).

Agradecemos a la comunidad por su paciencia y apoyo, y esperamos continuar fortaleciendo nuestra relación.
