Wastewater

- Lagoon depths: Large Lagoon is 11.25 feet, and Small Lagoon is 6.00 feet
- Pump 2 failure at Del Tech. Found transducer not reading. Put spare transducer in still not working. Ordered new controller and installed still not working. After talking with tech support, they found out that the transducer they had sent was the wrong one. Wired up spare from Main Station back to normal
- Met with Hopkins construction at the pumpstations that are going to be upgraded. Work to begin shortly
- Advised by DNREC that permit renewal anticipated by early summer (goal not necessarily a commitment) – permits are being prioritized based on several factors including, other permitting, compliance, and enforcement
- Talking with Sussex County about resuming sludge hauling, hopefully by end of next week
- DBF sent a list of pumpstations to be reviewed and updated from 2011 inspection reports if needed. New inspection will be scheduled after updating

- Working on road smoothing at Stevenson Lane
- Fixed overhead lights in Public Works garage area
- Fountain Craft came and did a pressure on Circle fountain – sending a quote to repair

- Requested updated ditch clearing agreement from Sussex Conservation District
- Cleaned storm drains after storm
- Relocate flower planters to Wilson Park until road work is done at railroad crossing
- Performed regular maintenance of Town properties and bike trail

- Restarted SCI and Del-Tech wells to take samples from them, as well as King Street and South Railroad sent to be analyzed
- Needed Dawson & Bedsworth in to rewire SCI (to get well running)
- Noticed noise from Well S2, contacted AC Schultes to come and inspect
- State water test 1 done for the month
- Contacted Elvin Schrock to get on the schedule for installing meters at the Oaks
- Keystone replaced parts that went down at King Street Plant – now have 2 spares
- Sprig replaced 2 large meters (The Circle and North Race Street)

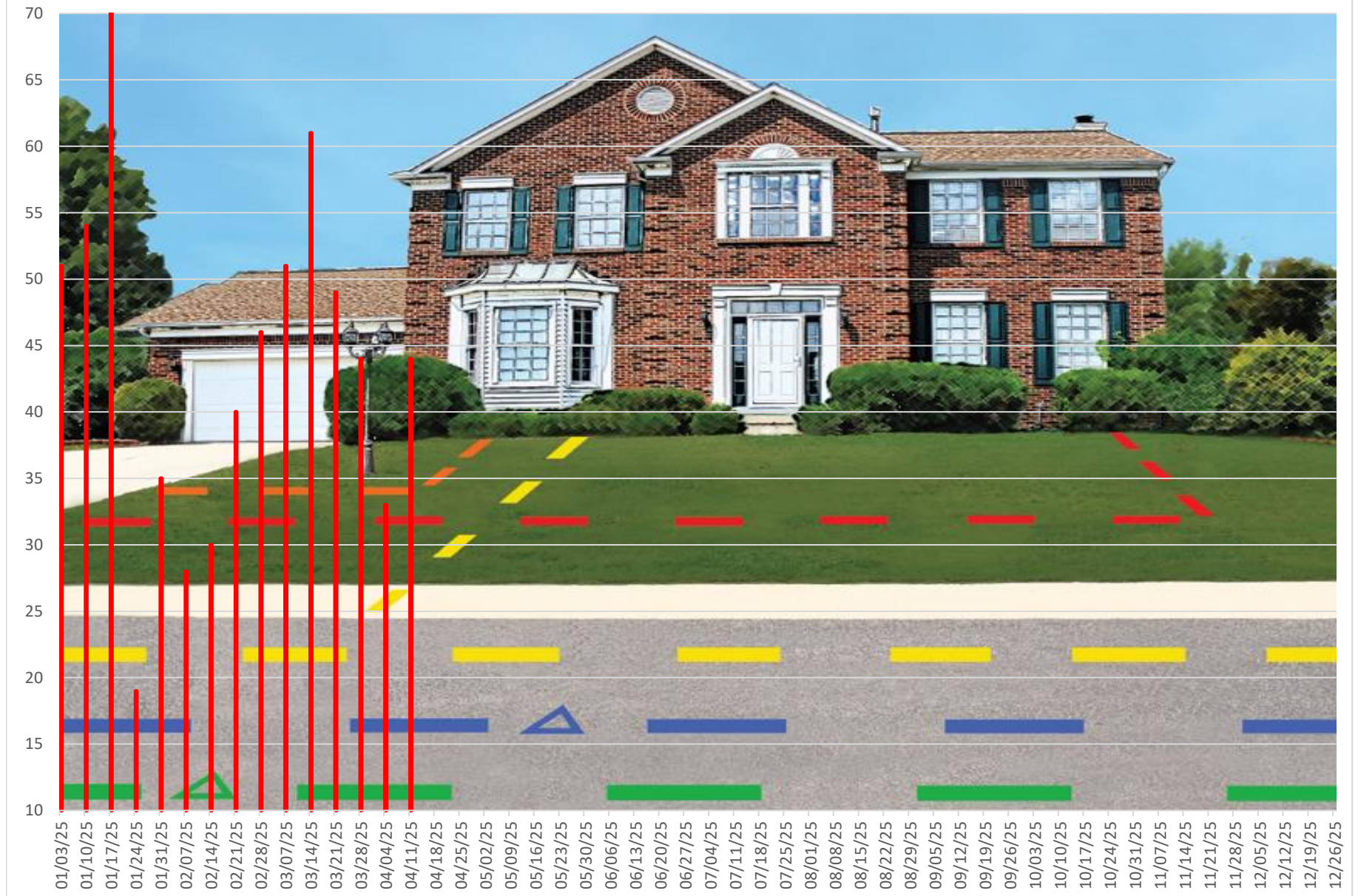

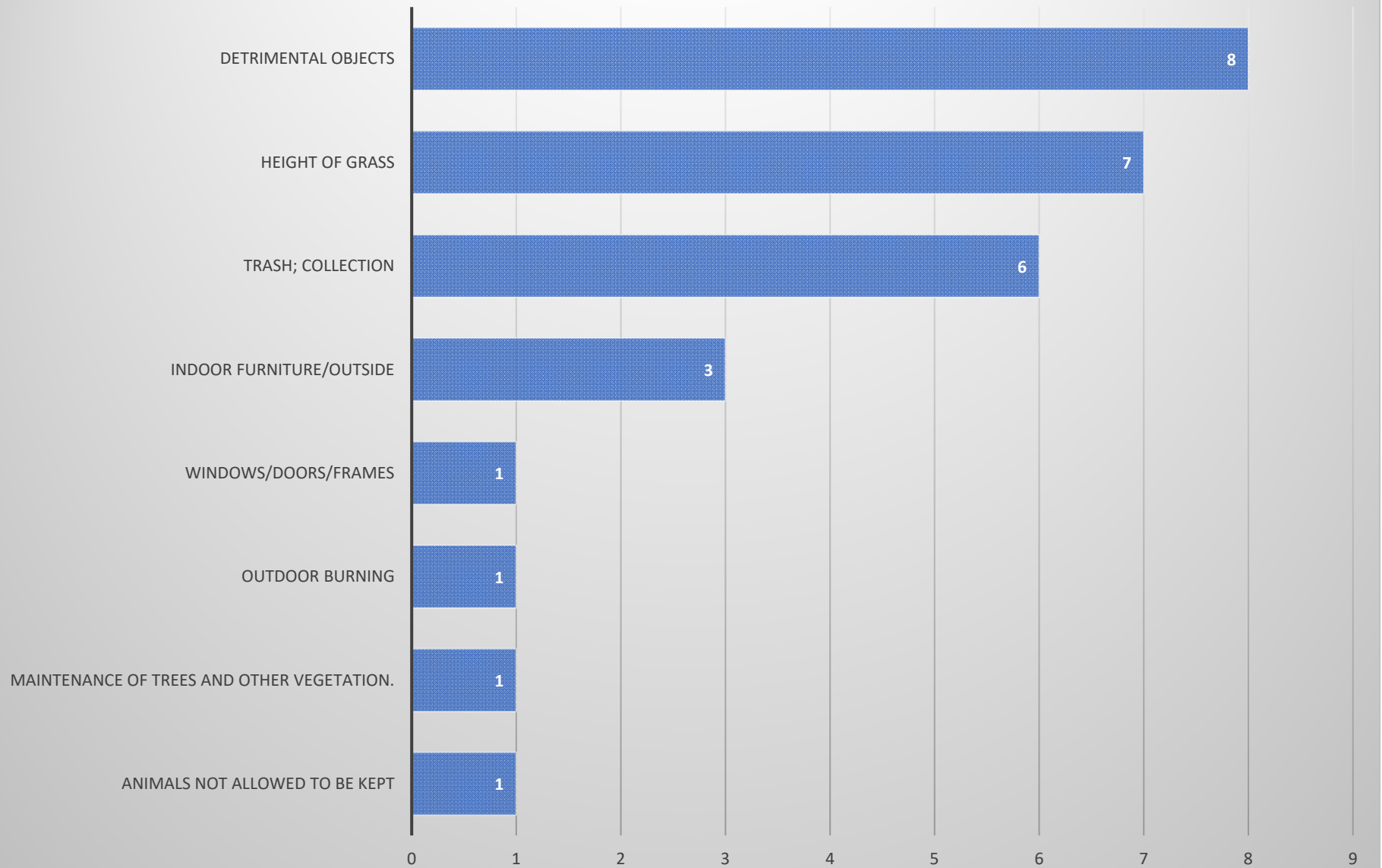

Code Violations April 4, 2025 to April 10, 2025





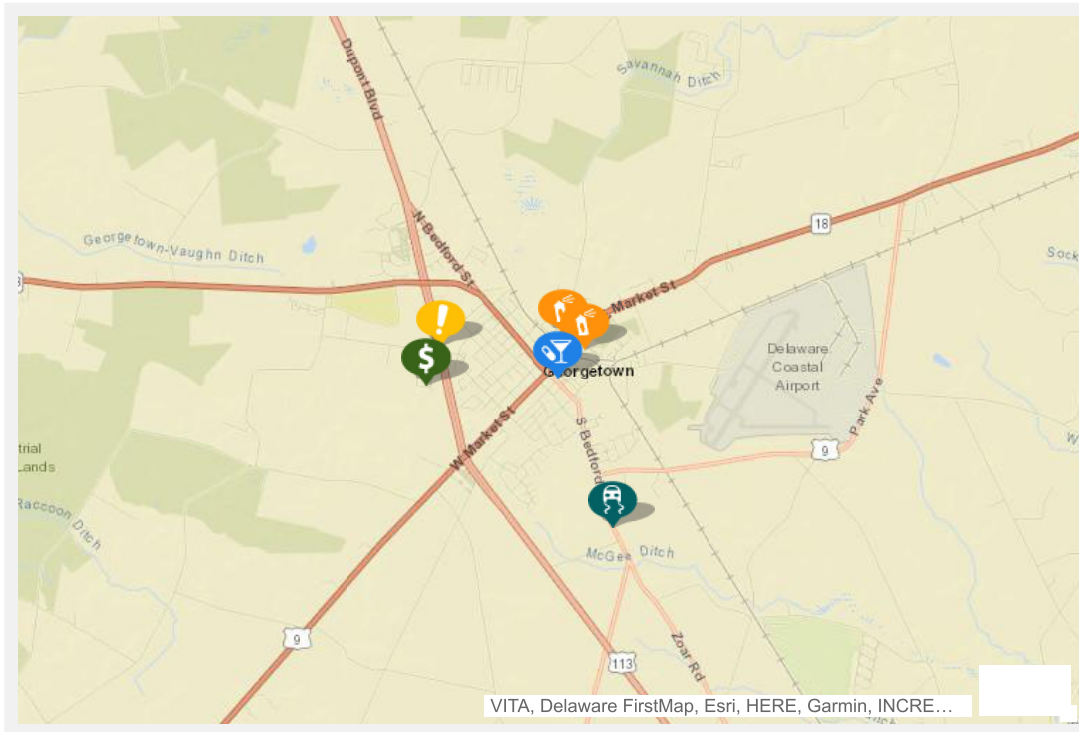

What type of businesses would you like to see more of in our town?



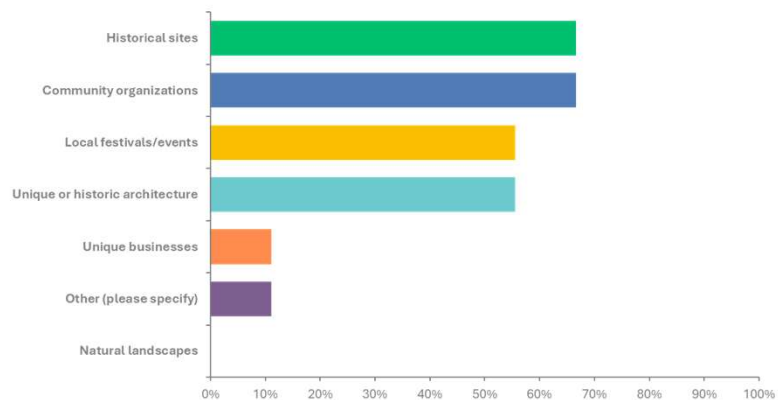

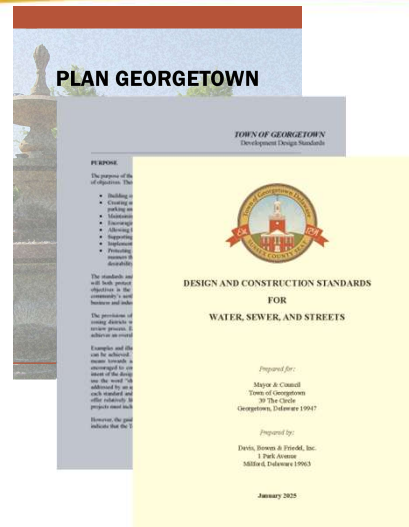
Town Council

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Emergency Services – Big Picture

- The funding and volunteer crisis is not for the Town of Georgetown to single handedly resolve

- A uniform fee, across the entire fire district, should be vetted
- **Caution:** As new revenue sources are added, there is a risk of losing others (current State/County sources)

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
